EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

- 1. Responsible for the daily operation of the site in compliance with licensing and Head Start Performance Standards together.
- 2. Teach a group of children ages 3-5.
- 3. Plan, develop and carry out classroom goals and objectives.
- 4. Ability to carry out lesson plans, prepared by the regular Site Supervisor.
- 5. Participate in parent center meetings; maintain ongoing communication with parents.
- 6. Supervise site staff.
- 7. Responsible for site reporting and other administrative tasks.
- 8. Communicate pertinent information resulting from the day's events to regular Site Supervisor

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. BA degree in Early Childhood Education, Child Development or related field
- 2. A minimum of 3 years actual classroom teaching experience
- 3. Proof of completion of core ECE courses (ECE 201 Child Development, ECE 210 Early Childhood Education Principles, ECE 211 Early Childhood Education Curriculum, ECE 212 Child Family and Community)
- 4. Current California Child Development Site Supervisor Permit
- 5. Current Department of Justice/FBI Child Abuse Index Clearance
- 6. Recent tubercular clearance (within past six (6) months)
- 7. Current Pediatric CPR and First Aid certification
- 8. Health examination upon employment
- 9. Holds a valid California Driver's license and proof of insurance
- 10. Regular attendance and punctuality are an essential function of the job.
- 11. Must be able to occasionally lift and/or move a child (up to 50 pounds)
- 12. Bilingual in Spanish highly preferred

SELECTION PROCESS:

Applicants will be reviewed by a screening committee for satisfaction of minimum qualification standards. All applicants must submit their transcript of records with their application. Those applicants evidencing the best qualifications will be invited for a panel interview evaluation. All candidates interviewed will be notified in writing following interview evaluation.
